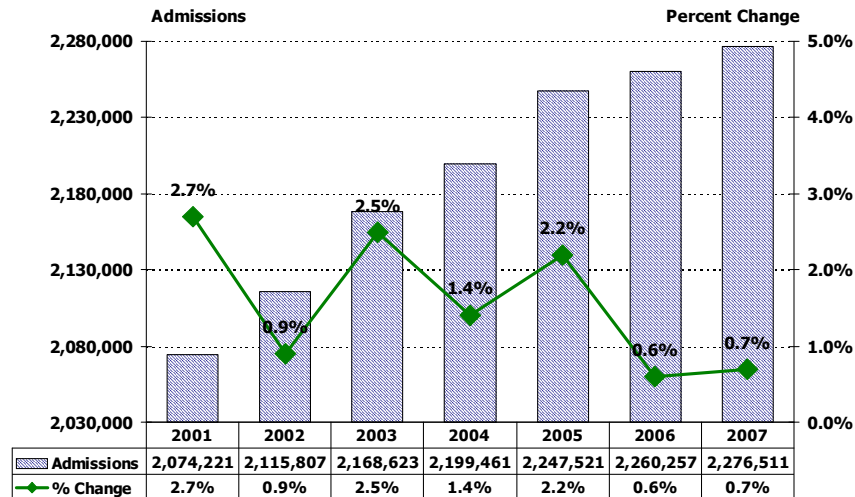

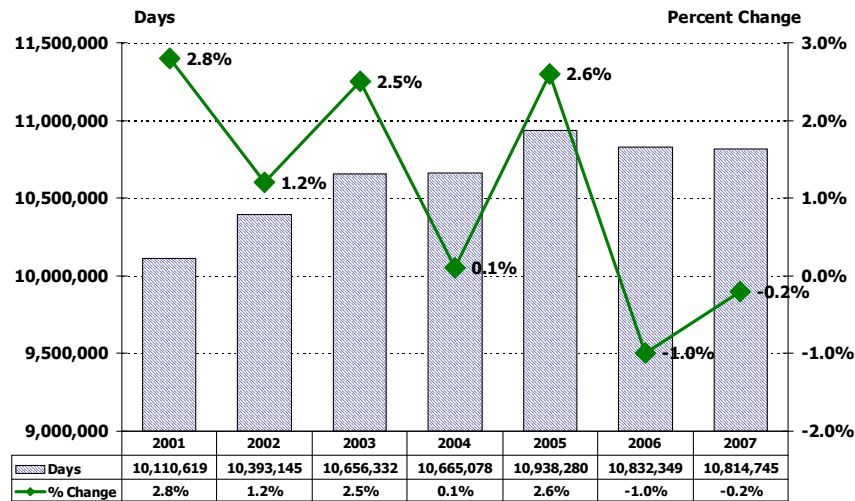
Twelve Months Ending Third Quarter 2001 - Third Quarter 2007

## Inpatient Days in Florida Hospitals

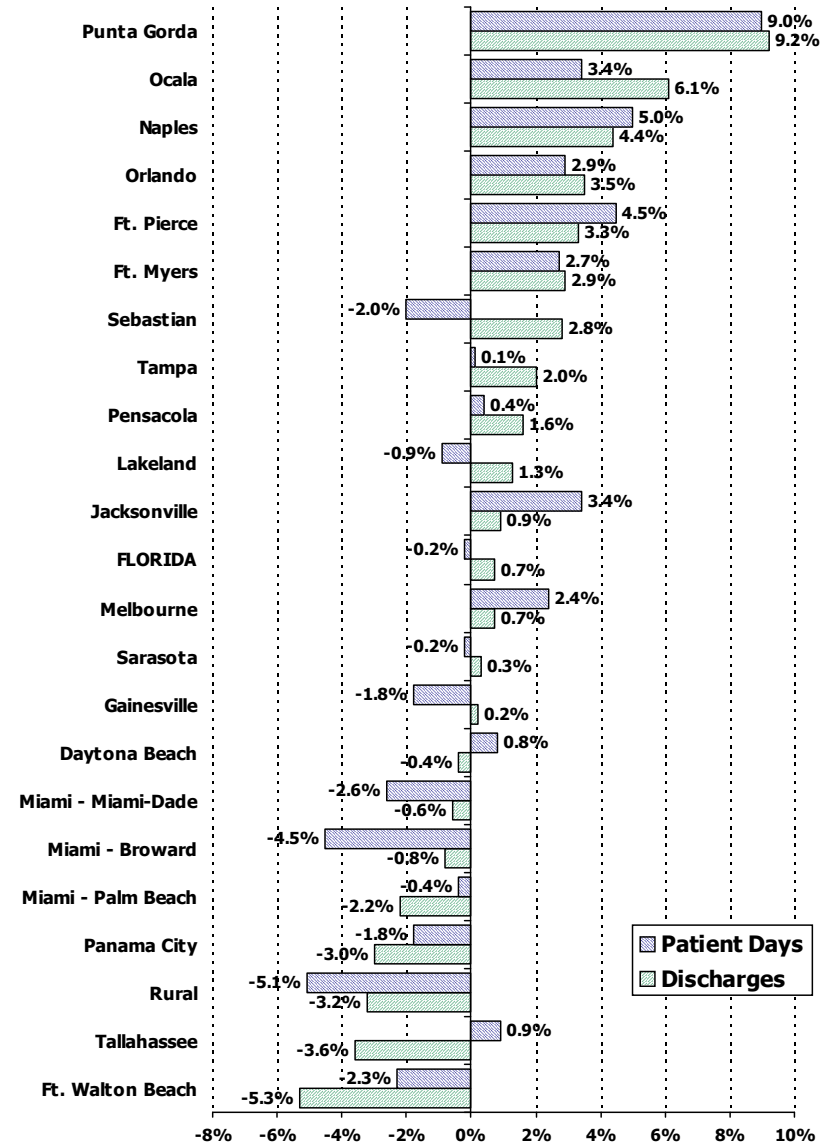

## Change in Admissions and Patient Days by MSA

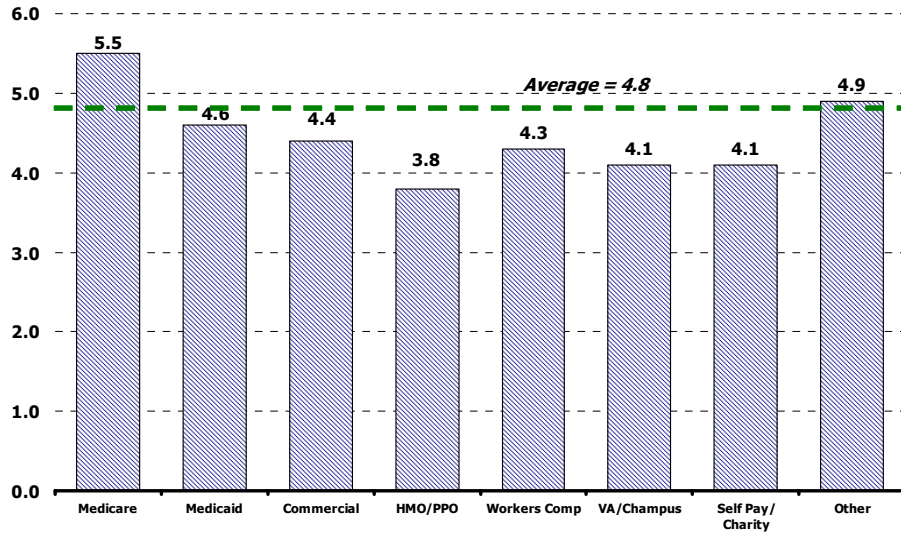
Twelve Months Ending Third Quarter, 2006 vs. Third Quarter 2007

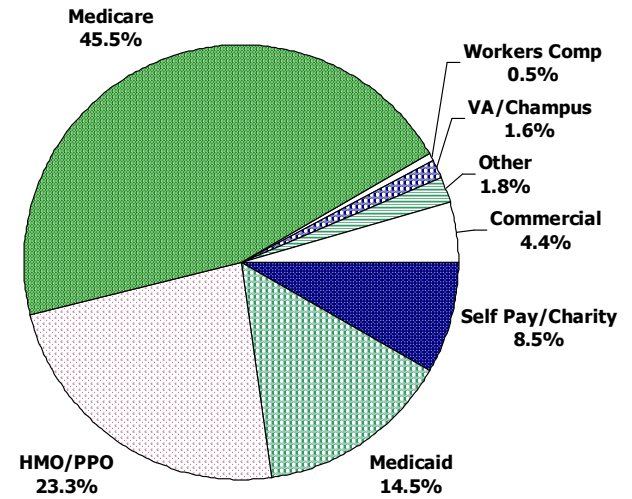

### Average Length of Stay by Payer Twelve Months Ending Third Quarter 2007



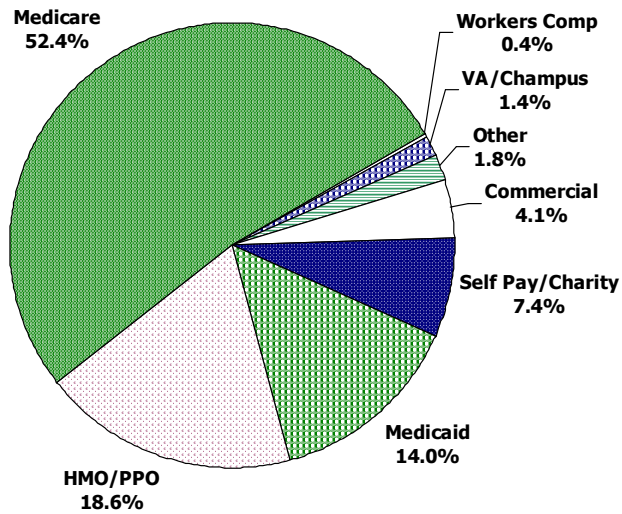
### Admissions by Payer Category Twelve Months Ending Third Quarter 2007

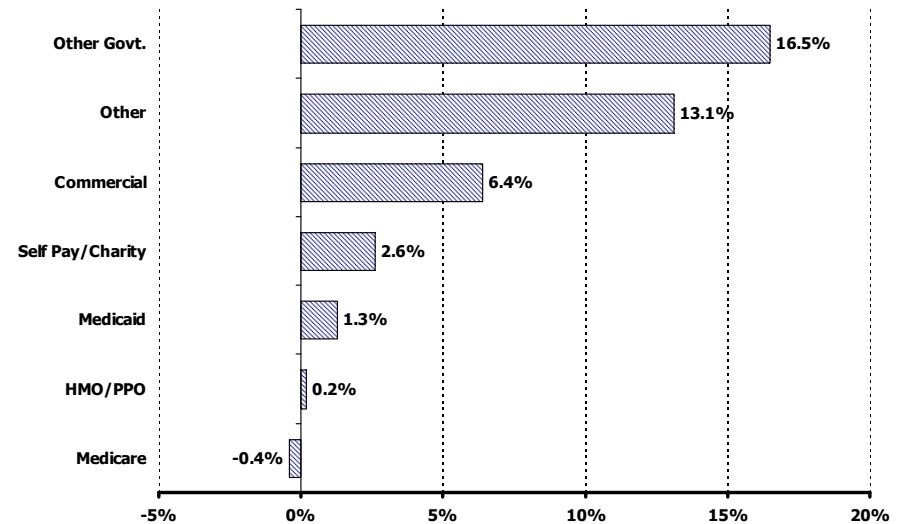


### Patient Days by Payer Category Twelve Months Ending Third Quarter 2007

Total Patient Days: 10,814,745



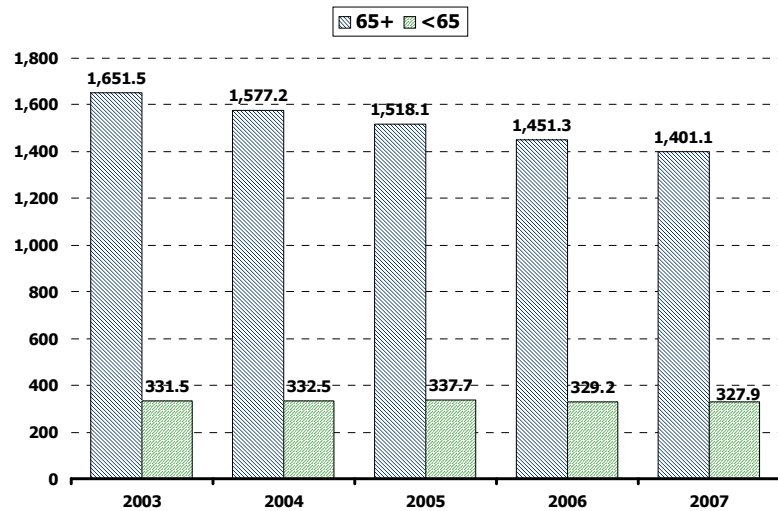
### Changes in Admissions by Payer Category Twelve Months Ending Third Quarter 2006 vs. Third Quarter 2007

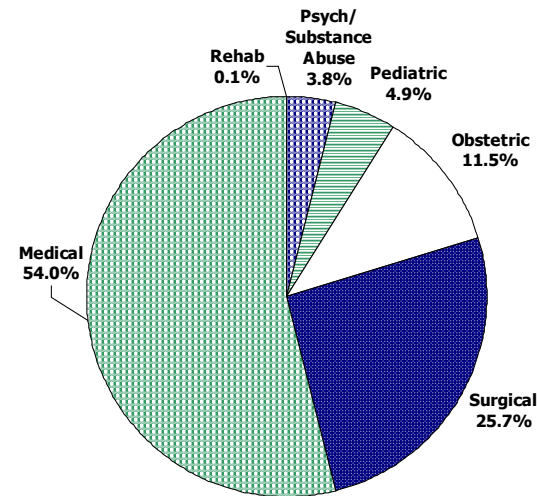
## Patient Days per 1000

Twelve Months Ending Third Quarter 2003 - Third Quarter 2007



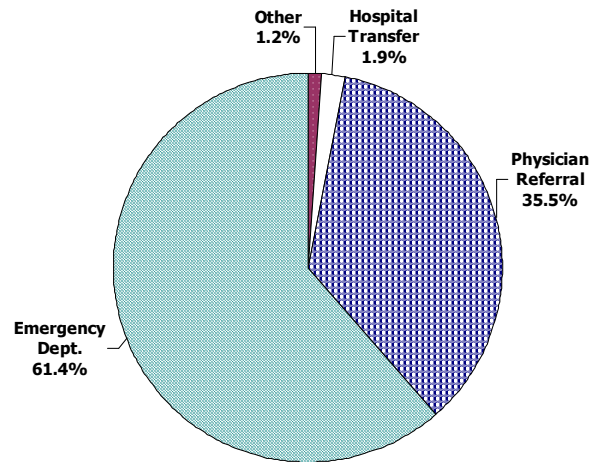
## Admissions by Type of Hospital Service
